Program Description

Come visit a place where children learn and grow through fun activities, exploration and play! A Place to Grow is a Five Star Child Center that serves children one to five years of age. The program is also a licensed Developmental Day Center that provides care for children with developmental delays. Children with developmental delays learn along side of children who are typically developing.

Certified teachers are on staff in classrooms ages three to five years. The teachers create a stimulating learning experience as they know the value of structure and play. Staff/child ratios are lower than other child care centers due to the programmatic demands of the center.
